## How to Download IIBF E-Certificate

If you are a banking and finance professional who has completed any of the courses or certifications offered by the Indian Institute of Banking and Finance (IIBF), you might be wondering how to download your e-certificate. On the next page, you will see a form where you need to enter your membership/registration number and security code. Your membership/registration number is the same as your login ID for IIBF website. Your security code is a six-digit number that is sent to your registered email address along with your e-certificate. Enter these details correctly and click on "Submit".

### Step 3: Click on Get Details and Verify Your Information

After submitting the form, you will see a page with your personal details and examination details. Click on the button that says "Get Details" to view your e-certificate. Verify that your name, examination name, date of passing, grade, etc. are correct on the e-certificate. If you find any discrepancy, you can contact IIBF at [care@iibf.org.in](mailto:care@iibf.org.in) or call them at 022-2218 3302 / 2218 5134.

### Step 4: Download and Save Your E-Certificate

If everything is correct on your e-certificate, you can download it by clicking on the button that says "Download". You can also print it by clicking on the button that says "Print". Save your e-certificate in a secure location on your device or cloud storage. You can also email it to yourself or anyone else who needs it.

## How to Verify Your IIBF E-Certificate?

After downloading your IIBF e-certificate, you might want to verify its authenticity and validity. You can do this by checking the digital signature and scanning the QR code on your e-certificate. Here

are the steps to verify your IIBF e-certificate:

## Steps to Verify Your IIBF E-Certificate

### Step 1: Open Your E-Certificate File in Adobe Acrobat Reader

Open Adobe Acrobat Reader on your device and locate your e-certificate file. Double-click on the file to open it in Adobe Acrobat Reader. You will see a blue ribbon at the top of the file that says "Certified by iibfnoreplymail@iibf.org.in". This means that the file has been digitally signed by IIBF.

### Step 2: Click on the Signature Panel Icon

Click on the signature panel icon at the top right corner of the file. This will open a window that shows the signature status and certificate details. The signature status should say "Signed and all signatures are valid" and "The document has not been modified since this signature was applied". The certificate details should show the name of the signer, the date and time of signing, and the reason for signing.

### Step 3: Check the Signature Status and Certificate Details

Check that the signature status and certificate details match with your e-certificate information. If they do, then your e-certificate is authentic and valid. If they don't, then your e-certificate might be fake or tampered with. In that case, you should contact IIBF immediately and report the issue.

## FAQs on IIBF E-Certificate

- 1. Q: How long does it take to receive my IIBF e-certificate after passing the examination?**

You can also check your membership/registration number and email address on the IIBF website at [www.iibf.org.in](http://www.iibf.org.in) and make sure they are correct.
- 5. Q: What if I lose or delete my IIBF e-certificate or security code?**
- 6. A:** If you lose or delete your IIBF e-certificate or security code, you can download it again from the IIBF website using the same membership/registration number and security code. You can also contact IIBF and request them to resend your e-certificate or security code to your email address.
- 7. Q: Can I get a paper certificate along with my IIBF e-certificate?**
- 8. A:** Yes, you can get a paper certificate along with your IIBF e-certificate. However, you need to pay a nominal fee of Rs. 100/- per certificate plus GST and courier charges. You can apply for a paper certificate online through the IIBF website or offline by sending a request letter and a demand draft to the institute.
- 9. Q: Can I use my IIBF e-certificate for applying for jobs or higher studies?**
- 10. A:** Yes, you can use your IIBF e-certificate for applying for jobs or higher studies. Your IIBF e-certificate is a valid proof of your qualification and achievement in the banking and finance sector. However, some employers or institutions might ask for a paper certificate as well. In
