

AetherSX2: The Best PS2 Emulator for Android

The developer of AetherSX2 got the green light to use the PCSX2 code from the developers themselves and is licensed under the LGPL license — unlike the DamonPS2 developers, who stole the code and didn't follow the requisite license. In any event, the emulator was initially released in December 2021 via the Google Play Store as an open beta. You can also sideload the APK via the <u>AetherSX2 website</u>. We'd recommend you steer clear of any other websites claiming to offer the APK.

The emulator is free to download and use, so don't be duped by anyone saying you need to pay for it. This is in contrast to the DamonPS2 emulator, which is filled to the brim with ads and charges for a Pro version limited to two devices. In saying so, a major turn of events happened in March 2023 when the app was reportedly updated with ads. You can still find the older, ad-free versions of the app via the fan-run Discord server and this archived link. Otherwise, if you don't mind the ads, you can download the app via the Play Store using the button below.

AetherSX2 Requirements

Before you download and install AetherSX2, you need to make sure that your Android device meets the minimum and recommended requirements for running the emulator. Here are the specifications that you need to check:

- 1. Go to <u>https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.aethersx2.android&hl=en_US&gl=US</u> on your Android device's browser or open the Google Play Store app and search for "AetherSX2".
- 2. Tap on the "Install" button and accept the permissions that are requested by the app.
- 3. The app will start downloading and installing automatically. You can check the progress in your notification bar.
- 4. Once the installation is complete, tap on "Open" to launch AetherSX2.
